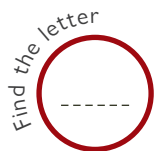


## 6. Print Room

Decorate this border with your own Morris-inspired leaves and flowers.



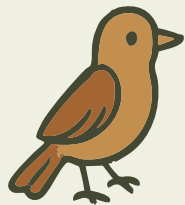
# The Strawberry Thief Trail

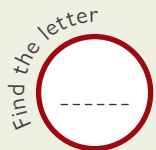
Congratulations! Take me to the front desk to collect your prize!

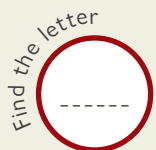
## 1. Coach House

Morris liked drawing and painting birds and flowers in his garden, but he has only finished half his pattern can you help complete it?

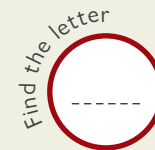


William Morris was an artist, designer, and writer who thought that beautiful things should be for everyone. He loved nature and made patterns full of little flower and birds.

Rest station – take a break and try out our activity area in our Library!

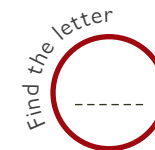


## 4. Library
