Let's Make an Angel Peg Doll!

We need:

- A wooden peg
- A sheet of kitchen roll
- A glue stick
- A pair of scissors
- Felt tip pens
- Biro pen or pencil
- A helpful adult
- Printed worksheet

Optional

Tissue paper/ wrapping paper/ ribbon/ wool



Let's begin:

1. Look at the worksheet. For each angel you need 4 pieces of robe, a pair of wings and arms (optional). Either draw your own robes and wings (and arms) directly on to a sheet of kitchen roll,

or if a printer is available you could ask an adult to print out the worksheet and use this as a template. You could also use paper, wrapping paper or tissue paper for some or all of your pieces.

2. Cut our the 4 robe pieces, the wings and arms, if you would like to decorate them with felt tips you can do this now.



3.

Glue the top part of one piece and stick it from just below the head to the chest on the front of the dolly peg.

Glue the top part of the second piece and stick it to the back of the dolly peg in the same way.

Glue the third and fourth pieces of robe at the top and stick them on to the sides of the dolly peg.







(If you decide to include arms, do these next. Put glue on the middle part of the arms and stick the arms on to the back of the dolly peg.)



4. Put glue on the middle part of the wings and stick them on the back of the dolly peg.



5. Your angel is now almost done, now you can add wool for the hair, or any other decorations you would like.



6. You can also hang you angel up by tying some wool or ribbon around the top of the peg.

You have made your angel! Now you just need to decide where to hang it up, how about on your Christmas tree? Here are some more examples to inspire you.
